Pastor Marilyn's Monthly Musings

If you're like me, sometimes this winter you wondered if spring would ever come, and now it's here! Sure there are the occasional attempts by winter to hang on a little longer, but according to the calendar and the greening grass and the spring flowers coming up it's spring! And that puts a big smile on my face and a lightness to my steps.

This month we're continuing our Hispanic/Latino cultural emphasis by learning about Chile through a Minute for Mission, a display in the Concourse, and sharing Chilean foods on April 3, and by sharing our Hispanic/Latino artifacts in a Concourse display April 10. I'm both looking forward to learning more about Chile, the birth country of Ryan Shannon and Kelsey Shannon, and seeing and hearing about the places others have visited in Central and South America.

Another thing I'm looking forward to on April 3 is hearing more about the Safe Families program benefiting children. This is our program for the after church Outreach and Mission Committee potluck this month.

Also this month, we're continuing our Lenten Bible studies and sermon series, concluding both during Holy Week. As part of our transformation process as well, we invite you to spend at least five minutes every day praying for five neighbors, for our team as they lead the Bible studies and for me as I prepare to preach, for those God may be leading us to serve and/or to invite to worship, and particularly for those God may be leading us to invite to our Easter Sunday worship.

This year during Holy Week we'll observe Maundy Thursday on April 21 by presenting a drama from the perspective of those who prepared the Last Supper for Jesus and his disciples, as well as sharing Communion and a potluck meal.

As always during Lent we are receiving the One Great Hour of Sharing offering, which among other things benefits Presbyterian Disaster Assistance and is a way for us to help Japanese sisters and brothers recovering from the triple disasters of earthquakes, tsunami, and nuclear reactor challenges. I'm looking forward to reading the weekly One Great Hour of Sharing bulletin inserts during April, and hearing the minutes for mission about those it helps.

Finally we end the month with the joy of our Easter celebration on April 24! We'll begin with our annual Easter breakfast, followed by our joyful worship, and the hoped-for opportunity to reconnect with family and friends as well as welcome visitors.




Easter Flowers

Session Meeting Highlights - March 15, 2011


- > Approved the February 17, 2011 Session meeting minutes
- > Received the 2010 annual statistical report to the Presbyterian Church (USA) and a 10-year analysis of those annual statistical reports prepared by Clerk Mike Holland
- > During the Property and Finance Committee report, received a brief report on the February monthly and year-to-date financials; and approved selling three of the churches unused pianos
- Received the monthly Pastor's report; and offered feedback to Pastor Marilyn on plans to send out a weekly prayer request for the Lenten Bible studies and sermon series, spending 5 minutes a day praying for 5 neighbors as well as for those we may invite to join us at Dale Heights
- > During the Christian Education Ministry Team report, heard reports on the Church School classes; heard an update on the Lunch & Learn study; and learned that a decision is still being made about doing a children's Easter skit during worship one Sunday
- > During the Personnel Committee report, learned that background checks for all employees and volunteers are current
- > Received the February 19, 2011 John Knox Presbytery report
- > During the Transformation Coordinating Team report heard that the team met weekly through March 2, and the next meeting will be March 30; heard reports on the beginning of a church-wide six-week Bible study during Lent, with study booklets and a brochure having been distributed during worship March 6 and by mail the following week; heard an update on the congregational Conference on the Past being planned for May 1; was reminded that there will be a transformation training for the Session on April 2 at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Madison; and that the next training for the transformation team will be May 14
- During the Outreach and Mission Committee report, learned another possible Habitat for Humanity build in April or May; that the committee is following up on possibly chartering one or more Scout troops; that in conjunction with Dale Heights Hispanic/Latino cultural emphasis they hosted Helen Madsen and Ginger McIntosh talking about their church's Guatemala mission trips on March 6; heard a report on hosting Road Home families at St. Luke's March 11; learned about upcoming informational potluck plans, including programs by Safe Families April 3; and that we will serve the Pres House Supper March 27
- > During the Worship and Music Committee report, learned that the next meeting is March 27; heard about plans to learn about Chile April 3 after having learned about Guatemala March 13 as part of Dale Heights Hispanic/Latino emphasis for Lent and Easter; learned that 11 participated in the Ash Wednesday class/service March 9; and that plans continue for doing a drama called *Beneath the Upper Room* on Maundy Thursday
- > During the Care and Fellowship Committee report heard a reminder that committees or groups hosting potlucks and potluck programs are responsible for the set-up and the clean-up
- > The next meeting will be April 26, 2011 with Mike Holland leading devotions.

Property & Finance Committee Meeting Highlights – March 8, 2011

- > No action yet on sound system extension, faucet replacements or repairs to garages.
- > Work days for spring grounds cleanup will be scheduled at April meeting.
- > Discussed enclosing sump pump in the fellowship hall.
- > Discussed replacing foam pads on posts in fellowship hall.
- > Discussed repairing or replacing concrete at office door entrance.
- > Financial report received. As of February 28, 2011, net income was -\$1,123 compared with a budgeted net income of -\$6,476. The large budgeted deficit at this time is due to some large expenses that occur early in the year and some payments which come in later in the year. Year-to-date actual income was \$2,878 over budget largely due to pre-paid pledges. Actual expenses were \$2,475 under budget.
- > The next meeting will be Tuesday, April 12 at 7pm.

Outreach & Mission Committee Meeting Highlights – March 6 and 20, 2011

- > Discussed the possibility of buying earth-friendly shopping bags for our members, visitors, and possibly others
- > Heard reports and updates on potluck programs, including the upcoming one on Safe Families April 3 and on Middleton Outreach Ministry May 15
- > Learned plans to provide the Pres House supper March 27 are in good order
- > Tabled action on possibly chartering one or more Scout troops pending receipt of some additional information
- > Learned the next Habitat for Humanity work day will probably be sometime in May
- > Discussed One Great Hour of Sharing minutes for mission plans for April
- > Discussed some possible "Concourse Café" ideas, including hosting a Middleton Outreach Ministry mobile food pantry, and establishing some kind of coffeehouse
- Reviewed the committee's mission disbursements for the past five years, discussed a proposal by Parish Associate Dietrich Gruen for prioritizing future disbursements, and began identifying disbursements for this year
- > Received a proposal from Dietrich for "growing the pie" for mission funds through a couple of extra fund-raising opportunities during the year
