### Session Meeting Highlights - July 28, 2010

- > Approved the May 25, 2010 Session meeting minutes
- During the Property and Finance Committee report, received a brief report on the May and June monthly and year-to-date financials, which showed a net income at the end of June of \$993, and a year-to-date net income of just over \$2,100; heard a report on the completion of the church basement storm water management project; heard reports of other repairs around the church this summer; discussed the upcoming fall stewardship campaign; and received an update from the joint Dale Heights-Sah-lang painting and redecorating task on its projects
- Received the monthly Pastor's report, received information about this year's Presbytery Day event in September, and agreed to invite Gwen Brandfass from the Committee on Ministry to the August Session meeting to conduct our triennial visit
- During the Christian Education Ministry Team report, heard reports on plans for the fall children's Church School activities
- During the Personnel Committee report, learned that background checks for all employees are current
- > There was no Inviting and Welcoming Ministry Team report
- Met with Anne and Grant Lembcke and approved their request to have their son, Aaron Joseph Lembcke, baptized during morning worship August 8
- Approved a request from Pres House to provide Sunday suppers October 24, 2010 and March 27, 2011 for their students
- During the Outreach and Mission Committee report, heard a report on the Rev. Gary Catterson, pastor of Community Presbyterian Church in Postville, IA and a member of the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance National Response Team's program during a potluck June 27; and learned that Gale Oakes is stepping down as chair
- During the Worship and Music Committee report, learned that choir rehearsals will be moving from Thursday to Wednesday evenings this fall; heard a report that the next cultural emphasis will be Swiss/German/Netherlands for Advent/Christmas; and that the next meeting is August 29
- > The next meeting will be August 26, 2010 with Kim Chan leading devotions.

### Property & Finance Meeting Highlights - July 13, 2010

- Storm water management drain and pump project completed except for baseboard which needs to be ordered. Fifty-four tiles were replaced without having to buy new ones. Thanks to committee members who cut, stained and installed the new look—wainscoting and paneling.
- Successful Sah-lang/Dale Heights July work day. Fellowship hall was cleaned up and all remaining bark for the grounds was spread. Some pruning will take place later this year on selected trees on the lawn and in the Memorial Garden.
- > Painting/redecorating task force cancelled one paint day but will work on July, 16.
- > Due to possible City of Madison plans for University Avenue/Norman Way work, we will delay for now paying off the complete sidewalk assessment.
- > New tractor/mower is in use. Purchased for \$2,100 in June.
- > Programming of newer computer is ongoing, but complicated by limited capacity on current machine.
- Other building /maintenance projects completed. New bearing and seals on furnace pump and basement bathroom are fixed. Elevator quit working one day but was fixed by committee member.
- > Finances are in fairly good shape. Budget statement shows and actual net income year-to-date of \$2121 versus a projected year-to-date budget deficit of \$3,096.
- > The next meeting will be Tuesday, August 10, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

# Christian Education Ministry Team Meeting Highlights – July 25, 2010

- ➤ Kim Chan presented the plans for the 2010-2011 preschool Sunday school class.
- > The first day of Sunday School will be September 12. It will be a casual Sunday followed by an indoor potluck meal.
- A new curriculum will be purchased to go with the Spark Bibles which have already been purchased for the younger children. We will use the Fall curriculum to assess the program before we purchase the Spring curriculum.
- ➤ One of the tables will be made shorter and carpet squares will be gotten so the story time can be done sitting on the floor.
- There are five individuals (Kim Chan, Sophie Jakovich, Gale Oakes, Vreni Straubhaar and Sandy Weigt) who will be teaching.
- The Adult Sunday School took the summer off and it is expected to resume in the Fall.
- ➤ The Wednesday Lunch and Learn group will continue. When one subject is ended, a new one is decided upon by the group.
- There will be a children's Christmas program again this year some Sunday in December.
- ➤ The children will be presenting the song "Jesus Loves Me" during worship sometime in the Fall. Sophie will accompany them with the accordion. Another song will be presented in the Spring.
- This children will be encouraged to help usher and will make some floating banners to swing in the aisles during the opening hymn. They will make them during Sunday School.



Would you like to learn more about homeless services in Madison? Join members from faith communities all over Madison on Tuesday, August 10th to hear presentations from the non-profit groups who are providing emergency shelter, including The Road Home.

Starting at 5pm, dinner will be provided, along with a game or activity for your table to begin to engage the issue of homelessness in Madison. A suggested donation of \$10 is asked to off-set the cost of the meal. From 6-7pm, each of the non-profits (The Road Home, Salvation Army, Porchlight, Domestic Abuse Intervention Services, and YWCA) will present about their organization and how they are providing shelter followed by a question-and-answer session. At 7pm, people are free to leave or stay with their congregation or organization to debrief about what they heard for half-an-hour.
