Property & Finance Meeting Highlights - January 10, 2012

- > Heat tape for office entrance roof has been hooked up. Will create a channel through ice and snow to speed clearing.
- > Sound system: new lavaliere microphone needed.
- 2012 University Ave. reconstruction: At a Board of Public Works meeting December 14, learned that construction hours will be extended from 7 am to 7 pm, with bridge traffic detoured and surface paving taking place during hours of 10 pm to 6 am. Private utilities can work at anytime. One-lane traffic, gasoline engine blowers, and access disruption should be expected, through Craig Avenue will also serve to provide access to our church. Our representative at the meeting explained that the church has activities throughout the week and that access and noise are concerns. Construction will start after March with November as the hoped-for completion. A website with weekly updates and email messages will provide notification of working hours.
- > Air Quality Systems (HVAC contract holder approved by Session) completed the Fall 2011 maintenance last week. Noted: a need for a bigger access space for this type of work.
- Preparation of end-of-year tax reports is ongoing. The through-November pledge statements have been distributed.
- Stewardship campaign completed. 2012 Draft Budget, likewise. Note: any operating surplus funds from 2011 (and later, 2012) will be allocated to a Capital Improvement Fund.
- > Sidewalk is now completely paid up. Office entrance sign (\$300) has been paid for with memorial funds money.
- > Financial status reports reviewed. Net year-to-date income is \$5086 over net budgeted income figure.
- Next meeting: Tuesday, February 14, 2012 at 7 p.m.

Called Session Meeting Highlights – January 15, 2012

- Received the Nominating Committee report to place in nomination during the upcoming annual congregation/corporation meeting Caroline Pope as a Ruling Elder on Session for the Class of 2013, a two-year unexpired term
- Met with the Transformation Coordinating Team to receive and respond to information gleaned from the past year's conferences on the past and present, and upcoming plans and activities

Stated Session Meeting Highlights - January 25, 2012

- > Examined new Session members
- > Re-elected Mike Holland Clerk of Session for 2012; elected Kim Chan and Sandy Weigt to share serving as 2012 commissioner to John Knox Presbytery meetings
- Signed up for 2012 Session Committees
- > During the Clerk's report, approved the minutes of the December 20, 2011 stated Session meeting, and the January 15, 2012 called Session meeting
- > During the Property & Finance Committee report received a brief report on the December monthly and year-end financials; heard an update on replacing the sanctuary sound system; approved with thanks to Dick Corey and the Finance Committee a 2012 budget projecting income of \$147,484, expenses of \$143,620, and a surplus of \$3,864; and received an update on church redecorating plans, including that the office entry welcome sign has been temporarily hung and was dedicated during worship January 15, 2012
- > Received the monthly Pastor's report
- > During the Christian Education Ministry Team report heard updates on the weekly children's church school and on the Wednesday Lunch & Learn class
- > During the Personnel Committee report learned that all employee and volunteer background checks are current
- > Received the November 15, 2011 John Knox Presbytery report
- > Denied a request to host the 2013 Madison Prayer for Christian Unity service
- > Postponed having a Session retreat to work on a Session manual till the summer
- During the Transformation Team report heard an update on recruiting Vision Panel members; heard a report that a congregation-wide Bible study began January 22, 2012; and that the next meeting will be February 23, 2012
- During the Outreach & Mission Committee report was reminded that the next Pres House Supper will be March 25, 2012
- > During the Worship & Music Committee report approved offering an opportunity to sing praise hymns 10 minutes before worship once a month on the Sundays when the choir is not singing; learned there are plans to observe Mardi Gras in worship and fellowship February 19, 2012; approved holding this year's Ash Wednesday worship in conjunction with the noon Wednesday Lunch & learn class on February 22, 2012; heard about plans to have a Maundy Thursday potluck communion observance on April 5, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.; learned the Lent-Easter cultural emphasis will be Korean; learned the Celebrate the Gifts of Women service is planned for March 4, 2012; learned Rev. Gary Reynolds will be the guest preacher March 25, 2012; and approved a joint 55th and 5th anniversary celebration service with the Sah-lang Church for April 29, 2012, with former pastors and members to be invited
- During the Nominating Committee report approved installing Ruling Elder Caroline Pope during worship February 5, 2012, pending her election on January 29, 2012
- > Set the next Session meeting for February 22, 2012 with Gerry Klump leading devotions

Worship and Music Committee Meeting Highlights – January 22, 2012

- > Learned that the Christmas Cantata went very well, and was well-received by the congregation.
- > Heard that Maggie is registered to attend the American Guild of Organists National Convention in Nashville in July. She will be gone July 1-6.
- > Choir schedule/repertoire are planned through June; a cantata proposed for Holy Week 2013.
- > Christmas carol singing before church was well received by the congregation. It will be recommended to Session to repeat the carol singing and possibly for other church seasons on Sundays when the choir does not sing.
- > Worship on Jan. 22, 29, Feb.5 & 12 will be coordinated with the next transformation Bible study.
- > Sandy Weigt will do the children's time on Souper Bowl Sunday, Jan. 29 and Feb. 5.
- > Heard that Andree Jakovich will be baptized on Feb. 26 with March 4th as the weather backup date. Jakovich's will provide music that Sunday. Twenty family members are expected.
- > Discussed observing Mardi Gras Sunday on Feb. 19 with beads & masks as table decorations and possibly having a King cake.
- > Lenten preparations: recommend to Session that Ash Wednesday on February 22 be celebrated with a service in conjunction with the Wed. Lunch & Learn over the noon hour and the Maundy Thursday service, April 5 to include a potluck at 6:00 p.m..
- > Lenten cultural emphasis to feature either Korea or Ireland. If Ireland is the emphasis, we will do something for St Patrick's Day, March 18. Marilyn will talk with Pastor Gam about someone from the congregation to talk about Korean culture, Lent & Easter traditions.
- > Celebrate the Gifts of Women Sunday is March 4, with Communion. This will shift to March 11 if the baptism is moved to March 4.
- > Pastor Marilyn will be on vacation March 19-25. Gary Reynolds will be our guest preacher on March 25.
- > Learned the transformation team is planning a congregational retreat sometime over the weekend of April 13-15, which may or may not impact Sunday worship.
- > Heard that this is Dale Heights' 55th anniversary year. Session recommended one "celebration Sunday", probably April 22 or 29. Marilyn suggested a joint service with Sah lang, who came to Dale Heights during its 50th anniversary year. If this is not possible, then we will look for another date this spring/early summer for a joint service with Sah lang.
- > Pentecost is May 27. Marilyn suggested having an outdoor service and/or a joint service with Sah lang. Marilyn will talk with Pastor Gam about the joint service.
- > Next Meeting Date: May 6, 2012 at 11:30.
