The Finance & Property Committee and The Session

Care Fellowship meeting - December 20, 2009

- > The emergency calling list is being updated and will be attached to the next directory.
- > The prayer list is being updated and will be attached to the next directory.
- > The church membership roll was reviewed.
- > At the moment no one is need of food delivered to them. Pastor Marilyn will alert us if she sees a need. It is felt that members of the congregation typically step up and help when there is a need.
- Many of our congregation have health concerns. We keep them in our prayers and are aware that they may need help. It seems most who need rides to church are getting them. If someone notices that an individual might need a ride, please let Pastor Marilyn or a committee member know.

Property & Finance Committee Meeting Highlights – December 13, 2009

- Under Old Business noted that Boley's is doing the snow removal; someone still needs to check back on one storm water management estimate; that the freeze protection project on water pipes in the furnace room has been completed; that the broken furniture loan garage lock has been replaced; and that the fall HVAC maintenance check has been completed
- Learned that during the fall HVAC maintenance check that one of the four furnaces is leaking considerable carbon monoxide outside and it is recommended it be replaced
- > Approved recommending to Session that the furnace be replaced in January at an estimated cost of \$3,500
- Reviewed the financial status through November, which showed a net income of just under \$700 for the month, and a year-to-date net income of just over \$9,100, noting that approximately \$6,700 of that net income is this year's increase in the church's investments market value
- Approved for recommendation to Session a 2010 budget that includes the estimated \$3,500 furnace replacement cost
- > Discussed the probable need to replace the parking lots this summer, and the need for a capital campaign to do so
- Approved installing a bulletin board near the guestbook table outside the sanctuary for Middleton Outreach Ministry notices
- > Learned of a problem with cars being parked overnight on the front lot; approved asking the Sah-lang church to park their van in the back lot and putting up no overnight parking signs on the front lot
- > The next meeting will be January 11, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

Session Meeting Highlights - December 15, 2009

- Approved the November 17, 2009 Session meeting and December 6, 2009 congregational meeting minutes
- During the Property and Finance Committee report, learned Madison Area Technical College is moving five more classes to Dale Heights in January; learned we have received the first tuition payment from private classes by MATC teachers at Dale Heights; learned one of the church's four furnaces is leaking significant carbon monoxide outside and that it is recommended it be replaced; approved replacing the furnace in January at an estimated cost of \$3.500; approved having carbon monoxide detectors installed in the church building; approved establishing a locked box in which various persons and groups using the church building may make donations to help offset snow removal costs; discussed the probability of the need to replace the church parking lots next summer and the need for a capital campaign for the project; learned that 2010 pledges are estimated to end up being around the same as for 2009; approved a provisional balanced 2010 operating budget of \$146,100; and received a brief report on the November monthly and yearto-date financials, which showed a monthly net income of just under \$700 and a year-to-date net income of just over \$9,100, noting that approximately \$6,700 of that net income is this year's increase in the church's investments market value
- Received the monthly Pastor's report, briefly reviewing two *The Presbyterian Outlook* handouts for future discussion
- During the Christian Education Ministry Team report, heard a report on the Christmas pageant; heard reports on the pre-school and adult Church School classes; and heard an update on the Lunch & Learn study
- During the Personnel Committee report, learned that background checks for all employees are current, and are on-going for new volunteers; and learned that employee annual reviews are being scheduled
- > There was no Inviting and Welcoming Ministry Team report
- During the Outreach and Mission Committee report, heard updates on the Middleton Outreach Ministry Sharing Christmas and Christmasfest dinners; heard a report on a recent Dane County United assembly and upcoming training events; and heard an update on the knitting/crocheting ministry
- During the Worship and Music Committee report, heard a report on celebrating Advent and Christmas Filipino-style; and approved the 2010 Communion Schedule
- > Noted that the Care & Fellowship Committee will meet December 20 to conduct the annual review of the membership rolls for recommendation to Session
- > Approved installing new church officers during morning worship January 3, 2010
- > Approved calling the annual congregation/corporation meeting to follow worship January 31, 2010
- Discussed holding a Session retreat in the spring after receiving the results from the next planned Natural Church Development survey
- > The next meeting will be January 20, 2010 with Kim Chan leading devotions.
