February 5, 2012, is the Super Bowl. We don't yet know who will be playing this year.

February 5, 2012, is the Souper Bowl of Caring. We know there will again be a simple lunch of soup (plus some other stuff) following worship in the lower concourse. There will be a vegetarian and a non vegetarian soup on the menu. A free will donation will be taken and 100% of the donated money will go to the Middleton Outreach Ministry.

Last year \$9.5 million in dollars and food was collected for local hunger-relief charities. This year's goal is \$11 million collected for hungerrelief charities in local communities.

The simple prayer that was said at the first Souper Bowl of Caring continues to inspire: "Lord, even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us be mindful of those who are without a bowl of soup to eat".

Session Meeting Highlights – December 20, 2011


- During the Clerk's report, approved the minutes of the November 9, 2011 stated Session meeting, and the December 4, 2011 called congregational meeting
- During the Property & Finance Committee report received a brief report on the November monthly and year-to-date financials; heard an update on replacing the sanctuary sound system; approved a new HVAC maintenance contract with Air Quality Systems for \$1,200; approved a preliminary budget projecting income of \$148,684, expenses of \$143,310, and a surplus of \$5,374; approved designating any 2011 and 2012 operating budget surpluses for a capital improvement fund, which is particularly looking ahead to replacing the church parking lot; and received an update on church redecorating plans, including that the office entry welcome sign is finished and ready to be hung.
- Received the monthly Pastor's report, during which approved three days of compensatory time off February 7-9, 2012 to make up for her lost vacation time November 21-23, 2011; and approved her vacation request for March 19-25, 2012
- Approved a motion documenting the recall petition events and reaffirming the church's compliance with IRS law and PC(USA) policy
- During the Christian Education Ministry Team report celebrated the gorgeous children's Christmas pageant, and heard an update on the Wednesday Lunch & Learn class
- During the Personnel Committee report approved Music Director Maggie Rogers' request to rollover her 2010 continuing education funds into the 2012 amount for her to attend a conference; and approved Music Director/Administrative Assistant Maggie Rogers' and Custodian Rick Geiger's annual reviews
- During the Transformation Team report heard an update on recruiting Vision Panel members; heard a report on the next congregation-wide Bible study; called a Session meeting to meet with the Transformation Team following worship January 15, 2012; and learned the Transformation Team will meet with the Vision Panel for training by Coach Clara Thompson on January 11, 2012
- During the Outreach & Mission Committee report learned that the Christmas Joy Offering is currently being received; and was reminded that the next Pres House Supper will be March 25, 2012
- During the Worship & Music Committee report reviewed the weekly Christmas carol singa-long during Advent; heard that plans are set for the candlelight Christmas Eve worship and the Christmas Day Lessons & Carols service; approved the 2012 communion schedule; and that the next meeting will be January 22, 2012
- During the Care & Fellowship Committee report, approved moving Scott Hicks from the Inactive to the Active Roll and transferring his membership to Okemos Community Church in Okemos, MI; approved transferring Laura Doty's membership to St. Martin's Lutheran Church in Cross Plains, WI; and approved moving Richard King, Zack and Jenny Dachel, and Johanna Osten from the Active to the Inactive Roll
- During the Nominating Committee report, received with regret and thanks Barb Fleishman's resignation from Session; learned the committee needs to seek a nominee to fill Barb's two-year unexpired term; shared expressions of thanks to retiring Session members Barb Fleishman, Bill Mercer and Vreni Straubhaar; and approved installing Ruling Elders Tom Jones and Sandy Weigt during worship January 8, 2012
- Approved calling the annual Congregation/Corporation meeting, including electing a Ruling Elder to the Class of 2013, following worship January 29, 2012
- > Set the next Session meeting for January 25, 2012 with Kim leading devotions

Property & Finance Meeting Highlights – December 13, 2011

- Painting/redecorating task force on office entrance indoor sign is finished and ready to be hung.
- University Ave reconstruction: the main gas line project, including moving the church meter outside has been completed. We have also received our payment for the University Ave reconstruction project from the city, but probably won't receive our assessment bill till December, 2012.
- > Heat tape for roof has been laid out on office entrance and back entrance; will be hooked up at a future date.
- Recommended Session approve a new HVAC maintenance contract with Air Quality Systems for \$1,200
- Financial Status: As of November 30, 2011, net year-to-date income is -\$6,893 below net budgeted income figure—situation usually picks up in December, and Dick is projecting a year-end budget surplus.
- > The through-November pledge statements are ready to give out.
- Recommended to Session a 2012 draft budget projecting income of \$148,684, expenses of \$143,310, and a surplus of \$5,374.
- > Next meeting: Tuesday , January 10, 2012 at 7 p.m.

Care and Fellowship Meeting - November 27, 2011

- Individuals who have not been in church during the last year or so will be contacted to see what can be done to bring them back or find out if they have joined another church.
- > Emergency Church closing notification is working well.
- We are aware of rides being given to those who do not drive. If someone notices that someone might need a ride, we will see what can be done.
- > The church directory, emergency calling list and prayer tree will be updated.
- > The set up for Christmas Eve will be at 10 a.m. Christmas Eve day.
