We will be imagining our church faithfully and dynamically living out our Vision. Everyone will have an opportunity to provide input into planning and dreaming for the future of Dale Heights. We expect to have fun as we listen, share, experience and learn from each other.

Session Highlights

December 16, 2012

- During the Clerk of Session report, approved the November 18, 2012 stated Session meeting minutes; and the December 9, 2012 called Congregational meeting minutes.
- During the Property & Finance Committee report, heard a brief report on the November and year-to-date financials; learned that as of December 11 there were 26 financial pledges for 2013 received, which is about average; approved a motion that next year all potential financial giving units receive the stewardship letter and a pledge card; approved a preliminary 2013 budget, as amended; learned that Treasurer Harold Meyer will be stepping down from his office and from the committee at the end of the year; and discussed the upcoming capital campaign for the parking lot and other potential projects, including a new sanctuary air conditioner, improvements to the sound system, and new flooring in the Lounge and the Concourse kitchenette.
- Received the monthly Pastor's report.
- During the Care & Fellowship Committee report learned that plans are being made for Souper Bowl; and that the next meeting will be in March.
- During the Christian Education Ministry Team report heard updates on the children's and adult Church School, and the Wednesday Lunch & Learn.
- During the Nominating Committee report noted that new officers will be installed during worship Sunday, January 13, 2013.
- During the Outreach & Mission Committee report learned that \$100 of their remaining funds is still to be distributed; and that the Christmas Joy Offering promotion continues through Christmas Eve.
- During the Personnel Committee report learned all employee and volunteer background checks are current; approved a recommendation to give church staff Rick Geiger and Maggie Rogers three percent raises for 2013, and to recommend to the congregation increasing Pastor's Marilyn's terms of call by three percent; received Pastor Marilyn's annual review; and learned that Maggie Rogers' annual review is scheduled for December 19, 2012, and that Rick Geiger's annual review is still being scheduled.
- During the Transformation Coordinating Team report learned that a Soup Lunch will be provided by the team following the Conference on the Future January 20, 2013; approved calling a Session meeting with the team January 27, 2013 to work on next steps following the Conference on the Future; and received a revised Percept report for information.
- During the Worship & Music Committee report learned that the Advent-Christmas-Epiphany cultural emphasis on Eastern Europe continues through December 23, 2012; that the Lessons & Carols service plans for December 30, 2012 are being finalized; and that the next meeting will be January 13, 2013.
- During Miscellaneous Business approved calling the Annual Congregation/Corporation Meeting for January 27, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. for the purpose of receiving annual reports, electing corporation officers, and voting upon new Terms of Call for Pastor Marilyn; and offered expressions of gratitude for their service to retiring Session members Mike Holland and Gerry Klump.
- The next stated Session meeting was set for Sunday, January 20 2012 at 6:30 p.m. with Caroline Pope or Kim Chan leading devotions.

Property & Finance Committee Highlights December 11, 2012

- Sanctuary air-conditioning (leaking, though not broken) will not be included in the yearly budget at this point. If necessary, could be included in the coming capital campaign.
- Redecorating task force's next projects: second coat paint in fellowship hall stairwell in advance of painging "Welcome" lettering; meet to determine type of flooring for lounge and concourse kitchen.
- 2012 University Ave reconstruction: some work has been done to fix the Norman Way shoulder area.
- Lower restroom: overflow and leaks have been repaired.
- Floor cleaning machine: pricing models now to replace ancient model with a lighter one which also works on carpeting.
- Current Clerk of session Mike Holland brought along the manual of Operations which he is preparing.
 The PCUSA has recommended that each church prepare a manual and then bring it along to the Clerks'
 Minutes Review so that each church can see what other churches are doing.
- Harold Meyer, church Treasurer, let the committee know that he will not be treasurer next year. Committee received the news with regret, and thanks Harold for his valuable service.
- 2013 draft budget: was reviewed and discussed by the committee. An increase in the Outreach budget and several other adjustments were recommended.
- Pledges for the coming year: 26 pledges have been received so far.
- Financial status as of 11-30-2012: net budgeted income is \$3244. Special offerings for the year are at \$6605.
- Next meeting: Tuesday, January 8, 7pm.
