## **Property & Finance Meeting Highlights – October 11, 2011**

- Kittleson Landscape will make a site visit to discuss plantings for the left side of the office door. This garden will be the Todd Memorial Garden.
- Some landscape timbers have been installed and efforts continue to remove the yew stumps.
- > Redecorating Task Force: representative will meet with sign designer on Friday.
- Sound system: estimates will be sought from two companies. Each company will be asked to provide estimates for solving sanctuary sound problems, as well as adding on extras such as transmission to the concourse and nursery.
- Successful workday Saturday. Also progress on heat tape layout to prevent ice-dam problems.
- > Security system: one monitor installed, one still to be installed. Cost is around \$3000.
- Reconstruction of University Avenue in 2012: curb, gutter, and lights will cost about \$12,000. Dale Heights will receive \$13,840 for selling a corner of the property to the city.
- > Chimney repair: masonry company has been consulted. Will offer a report next week.
- Stewardship campaign: a song has been prepared to kick off the campaign. A letter will be prepared to send out the week before October 30.
- > Wooden doors at landing of steps are not closing properly. Investigate solution.
- Financial Status: third quarter income is traditionally low. This year is no exception. Net income is -\$5413 below net budgeted income. However, most of local outreach has been paid up-to-date and non-MATC class building use income is up \$711 over expected.
- > Next meeting: Tuesday November 8, 2011 at 7 p.m.
